Kate Morgan is supporter number one of Dublin city football team .Kate will travel anywhere in Britain to see her team in action .Last year she saw them play at every football ground in Britain .

Kate doesn't let anything stand in the way of her Saturday afternoon match – even her motherhood !two weeks after her son David was born, kate was back to cheer the team on –while her parents were at home babysitting ! « they cared for David until he was about seven and then I started taking him to matches with me, but he didn't enjoy it as much as me. In fact no one I know does. My family and friends all think I am a bit crazy ! some people would say I am too preoccupied with football but I don't agree.

It's just an important part of my life » .

She admits it is a costly hobby, especially going to away matches, because she prefers to drive herself rather than travel on the supporters' bus as she gets sick on coaches.

« My season ticket costs £180 a year but that's only for home games, for away matches, I spend about £60 each time on petrol, entrance fees, food and hotels. »

So how does kate manage ? « I don't drink or smoke and rarely go out , I can't remember the last time I went to parties or out, I can't remember the last time I went to the cinema or theatre, » she explains.

Kate has another passion : cricket. « I love cricket although not as much as football. I start watching in April but only if there's no football. »
